

The next Headway UK online Discussion Forum is on the 11th October at 1 o clock with Consultant Neuro-psychologist Dr Rodger Weddell.

Rodger's philosophy is that all individuals with brain injury have a complex and unique set of abilities and circumstances. We are hoping that one or two of you will be prepared to share your experiences of brain injury with Rodger. We have found that these conversations, a) give food for thought and b) show people that they are not alone, and others share similar experiences. Rodger is never in a position to tell someone what they should or should not do but rather promote conversations and enable others to explore their own way forward.
