## Mark Kennedy

A brain injury survivor from Northants who has run over 100 half marathons, delivered inspirational speeches across the UK, and co-authored four books. Mark won the Alex Richardson Achiever of the Year, sponsored by Slater & Gordon.

### **Dean Harding**

A brain injury survivor from East London who secured £140,000 of funding for an early intervention initiative and has made it his life's mission to help others. Dean won the Stephen McAleese Outstanding Contribution to Headway, sponsored by No5 Barristers Chambers.

A devoted carer from Sefton who became her partner's primary carer after he sustained a traumatic brain injury. - If anything happens to you it notifies emergency services that someone you are responsible for needs support
- You get discounted access to local health and wellbeing services, and selected local shops and businesses
